Ministry Manager



A few years ago, the Upper Room changed their software system to Ministry Manager. Our local community, Columbus IN Area Emmaus, uses Ministry Manager to collect and record information about the Emmaus Walks. The other reason is to help Walk Lay Directors form teams to serve on the walks. We are reaching out to YOU to help us make sure your information in the Ministry Manager is current and up to date.

At the next Gathering, we will have some laptops that can be used to update your profile if you need some additional help navigating Ministry Manager.

However, you don't have to wait until the next Gathering to update your profile. You can use the instructions below to update your profile at home.

Go to https://ministrymanager.upperroom.org/

***Please note that you must have your own personal email address. You cannot share it with another member such as a spouse.

"When you log into your Ministry Manager account, you will be directed to this page. This is your home page. Find the link in the upper right-hand corner of the page that says 'My account.' Click the 'My account' link to open your personal profile."

"When you click the 'My account' link, your personal profile information will display. Complete all personal information. Please note that the block labeled 'Phone number' must be filled in, so enter your primary phone number in that block. Please select your gender. The gender is important for sorting rosters and lists. Click the 'Clergy' block if you are a member of the clergy. You may want to add a photo to further personalize your profile. Add a photo by clicking the 'Choose file' button and selecting a photo from the photos on your computer or other electronic device."

"Now click the 'Churches' tab to add your church to your personal profile. Add your church by clicking the blue 'Add a Church' link. Enter the name of your church in the search window. When you find your church, click on the church name, then click 'Add church.' The church will now appear in your list. Be aware that many churches have similar names, and some have the same name. For instance, if your church name begins with the word 'first,' there will be hundreds of options displayed until you add more words to the title to narrow the search. If your search returns multiple churches, check the city and state to be sure you select the correct church. If you cannot locate your church, or are not sure which one is correct, contact your community board of directors or data administrator."

"Now click the 'Sponsors' tab to add your sponsor. To begin, click the blue 'Add a Sponsor' link.
