Team Service Application Guidelines

One of the great joys of Emmaus is serving on team and giving back to others the blessings you received on your walk. Just like Abraham, you are "blessed to be a blessing" and we want to provide you the opportunity to serve.

Please consider the following guidelines:

If you have already thought and prayed about working on the next Walk, please fill out the form.

Prior service is not required. The team selection committee follows the 1/3 Guideline. (1/3 first time workers, 1/3 semi-experienced, and 1/3 experienced).

Team selection must also balance the team by church and denomination. Because of these guidelines submitting an application does not always mean you will be selected to serve.

Filling out an application is only good for the next walk. You need to fill out an application before each walk on which you wish to work.

Applications will not carry over to the next walk.

Filling out an application helps the team selection committee decide who is available to serve and cuts down on unnecessary phone calls.

Prayerfully consider passing on the blessing and serving on team!

Ministry Manager – Update your information



We need your help to keep your information current in the database for Emmaus. The Walk Lay Directors utilize the database to locate contact information. Please take a moment to verify your personal information in Ministry Manager.

Go to ministrymanager.upperroom.org.

If you haven't signed up with an account, then click "Sign Up". Fill in the information to create your account.

If you get an error message that indicates that "Email has already been taken", then click on "Forgot Password" to reset it.

Here are some instructions from Ministry Manager

"When you log into your Ministry Manager account, you will be directed to this page. This is your home page. Find the link in the upper right-hand corner of the page that says 'My account.' Click the 'My account' link to open your personal profile."

"When you click the 'My account' link, your personal profile information will display. Complete all personal information. Please note that the block labeled 'Phone number' must be filled in, so enter your primary phone number in that block. Please select your gender. The gender is important for sorting rosters and lists. Click the 'Clergy' block if you are a member of the clergy. You may want to add a photo to further personalize your profile. Add a photo by clicking the 'Choose file' button and selecting a photo from the photos on your computer or other electronic device." "Now click the 'Churches' tab to add your church to your personal profile. Add your church by clicking the blue 'Add a Church' link. Enter the name of your church in the search window. When you find your church, click on the church name, then click 'Add church.' The church will now appear in your list. Be aware that many churches have similar names, and some have the same name. For instance, if your church name begins with the word 'first,' there will be hundreds of options displayed until you add more words to the title to narrow the search. If your search returns multiple churches, check the city and state to be sure you select the correct church. If you cannot locate your church, or are not sure which one is correct, contact your community board of directors or data administrator." "Now click the 'Sponsors' tab to add your sponsor. To begin, click the blue 'Add a Sponsor' link. Enter the name of your sponsor in the search window. When you locate your sponsor's name, click the name, then click ADD. Your sponsor's name will now appear in your list. Be aware that if your search returns multiple names, you need to check the identifying information to help you select the correct sponsor. If you cannot locate your sponsor, contact your community board of directors or data administrator."




