In an effort to prevent another flight cancellation, we have made the decision to host the flight as a day camp, where everyone will go home to sleep each night. With that in mind, being a sponsor for this flight is a bigger responsibility as we are asking sponsors to transport their caterpillars each day. We are asking each sponsor to please read the new sponsor guidelines. Sarah Humphrey will be calling each sponsor as applications are turned in, to make sure everyone understands the new changes and expectations for this flight.

Another change is Candlelight will be starting at 7:30 pm for the community at CCC. In an effort to end earlier to accommodate travel time for caterpillars, we are doing our best to streamline the schedule. Closing will be held at 4:45 pm at Sandy Hook UMC.

We would love to surprise the caterpillars with more faces from our community. We also can use table agape for our caterpillars (around 100 pieces). While this flight will not look like any we have had before, we are excited to bring the Chrysalis experience to teens in a way that is safest for all. Canceling flights has been difficult for everyone and we were not willing to take a risk of that happening once again. We appreciate any and all prayers as we work to provide the best experience for our caterpillars.
