Chrysalis is excited about the upcoming flights with Lay Directors Cody and Jessica Mosier, the weekend after Easter (April 15-17). The team is coming together and completed our training on February 17 -18. The training focused on minimizing ourselves as individuals and becoming the hands and feet of Christ for our Caterpillars.

We would ask the community for their support with prayer for the upcoming flights. Please consider sponsoring, or helping a youth sponsor caterpillars for the upcoming flights. Applications are available from the Columbus Emmaus website. There is a \$20 discount on applications received before March 31st.
