The Top Six Reasons . . .

There is a growing trend for society in general and our Emmaus community in particular to commit to attending events at the last minute. In the past the Board has wondered and talked about whether or not to cancel several walks because just days before a walk we did not have enough applications in hand. No walks have ever been canceled because of low attendance. Yes, indeed they were all good weekends. Yes, God was present on the walks, lives were changed, and God was blessed. So what is the big deal? For the sake of the pilgrim, the sponsor, the registrar, the kitchen, the lay director, and the board - ideally, the applications should be in at least a month ahead of time. Here is a brief explanation why:

PILGRIMS Prayer for a specific pilgrim by name cannot begin until the application is in. An acceptance letter that contains important information is sent to each pilgrim. This letter puts their minds at ease and helps them prepare for the weekend. After receiving this letter, the pilgrim can now arrange time off from work or arrange child care etc. The pilgrim enters the weekend in greater peace when the sponsor acts in a timely manner.

SPONSORS Sponsors, also, have greater peace. There are no frantic phone calls to the registrar; no scrambling to acquire agape letters. Sponsors can spend the month getting letters, setting the pilgrim at ease, and praying for their pilgrim.

REGISTRAR Do you know what the registrar's home life is like when 20 people don't get the applications in until the last week? Phone calls promising applications, phone calls inquiring if the application arrived, applications arriving, letters needing to be sent to pilgrims and sponsors, phone calls needing to be made because there is not enough time to send a letter, making arrangements for special needs. . . Need I mention a lack of peace?

KITCHEN Buying food for an Emmaus weekend is an enormous task. If the applications don't come in until the last week, then most of the food can't be purchased until just about the last day. If applications were in a month ahead of time, the kitchen could pace the shopping AND check the ads for sales during that entire month, as well as buy for special diets.

LAY DIRECTOR Lay directors are constantly evaluating and redirecting plans for the weekend. They are the ones in contact with the rest of the team regarding number of pilgrims attending. They are making the decisions about how many table leaders and assistants are needed. Without the applications they have no solid basis from which to give direction. After pouring themselves into this for six months, then the Board talks about the possibility that the walk may be canceled. Late applications just add to their enormous task.

THE BOARD It is a given that the board is responsible to see that walks take place and that the community continue. In our efforts to see that both happen, we are making this appeal to all of you to try to get the applications in one to two months before any given walk. All of our individual duties need time to be done well. Our collective responsibilities to the lay directors and the community need that time also.

This article has tried to illustrate the importance of getting applications in on time. You know right now that there are two walks coming in the Fall. Pray now. Pray about sponsoring. Talk to the prospective pilgrim now. Some will say yes immediately – give the application now. Some will need more time – give them more time, and more prayer. Don't wait until the last minute. Applications may be sent in now.

CHRYSTALIS NEWS

The Chrysalis flights #19 and #20 are coming up September 3- 5. Please continue to pray for Curt and Michelle Aton and the team as they continue to prepare for flights. We need caterpillars. We must have 9 girls and 9 boys to have a flight and so far we have 4 boys and 9 girls. If you know of a youth, it is not too late to sponsor. The deadline for applications is the Wednesday before the flight.
