A Note from Our Community Lay Director...

In case you didn't make it to the closings, I am pleased to report we had two spirit-filled walks in the Spring 2024. It seems each time I serve on a walk, I think none could get any better. Yet when I serve again, it just gets better.

It is never too soon to start praying for the next set of walks, so let's pray for Jeremy Keller and Debbie Raynor as they build their teams. Also, let's pray for willing and eager Emmaus workers to say yes to serving.

It is important to pray about who we are going to sponsor and be sure they meet the physical, emotional and spiritual guidelines for the weekend.

As we pray for pilgrims to register, let's participate in the "Prayer by Number" program. This is NOT the 72 Hour Prayer Vigil as this occurs before the walks. We have a sheet of paper with 36 spaces (a full walk) and we sign up to pray for a number, not knowing who that will be until about two weeks before the walks. For instance, if you sign up to pray for #21, then the 21st application received will be your pilgrim. The registrar puts a name by each number as she receives the applications. When the list is final, we receive an email letting us know who we were praying for. Keep praying for this person at least until the walk is over, and hopefully into his/her 4th Day. Please write an agape letter to your pilgrim and tell them how long you have prayed for him/her and share some personal information and encouraging words. We hope you can find him/her at closing and introduce yourself. Surprise connections have been discovered through this program.

Finally, it looks like the weather may allow us to have an April Gathering. Hope to see you at the First Baptist Church in Columbus for a pitch-in dinner and some hand-clapping music.

A Note from our Community Spiritual Director...

In my United Methodist tradition, the congregation often reads a Confession and Pardon as a preparation for receiving Holy Communion, but in a coin magazine I recently received, there was an article about an old and more personal method of preparing for Communion.

In the 1600's, at the Belgium cathedral in Liège, parishioners would first be interviewed by church elders to ensure they were deserving of Communion. They were then given a token, with a skull and crossbones on the obverse. When the time came, they would pass along that token to the priest, who would then administer the Sacrament to those deserving souls. These tokens are today known as "Saint Lambert's Communion tokens".

For me, I tend to focus on the undeserving aspect of Communion. It's a gift of grace to those who can never be worthy of it. If we were good enough, we wouldn't need it! But in fact, we all desperately need it. So we are invited to receive that undeserved and unconditional love of God.

May that wonderful Sacrament be less a time to prove our worthiness of it, and more a time to celebrate Jesus' worthiness of our love!
