You'll need the passwords columbusemmaus and 4thday to access this area; then click Help Documents for Walks; on the right side of the next screen, you'll see "Emmaus Sponsorship" and "Suggestions for Sponsors." Read these, and also print out applications from the web site.

Pray about whom you should ask, call them for a time to talk about Emmaus, and take along your applications. Remember, married persons should both be invited. **Time is running short.** Not only is it a shame for teams to be selected and go through their training only to be told "there are not enough Pilgrims for a Walk," but how many of our friends are missing this wonderful experience that maybe only we can offer (actually, God is offering it to them through us). Have the last persons you sponsored been sponsors yet? Maybe you can help them be sponsors as you sponsor your next Pilgrims. Won't it be a blessing to try to figure out how we can fit every applicant into the Walks?
