A Note from our Community Spiritual Director...

This Thanksgiving season, I am so thankful for our Emmaus Board, which has struggled through these pandemic months to make the best calls for our community.

In 2020, it wasn't too difficult to decide to retire that year's Walks, as many churches were closed and we had no vaccines. This spring, the situation hadn't changed much as vaccines were just making their rounds through the generations.

But this fall, I felt hopeful that our Walks could resume. I came to the Board meetings assuming they would happen, but then the Delta variant hit. Suddenly the tide had turned again, and we as a Board had to beseech God's wisdom to again make the best call.

So the members weighed in from their unique perspectives. Health care workers expected a surge in infections and hospitalizations around the time of our Walks. Others reminded us of God's favorite admonition - "Don't be afraid." We pondered how to have the safest possible Walks if we didn't mandate vaccinations of the Team or pilgrims. How could we practice social distancing, and how might the wearing of masks detract from the experience?

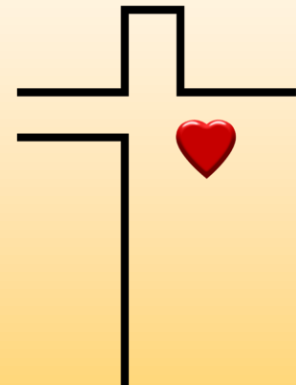
We were reminded that as the Walks drew near, Team members might drop off due to their own infections or a quarantine situation. Would we have enough willing and healthy volunteers available to step in? And if the Delta variant was especially striking children, would we accept the risk of a parent or grandparent getting infected on a Walk and taking it home? These certainly weren't all the thoughts offered and questions asked, but I offer this glimpse into how your Board struggled with so many unknowns and possibilities this fall.

In the end, we respected the different viewpoints shared, and chose the path of caring and precaution over our strong desire to hold these Walks. We reluctantly came to the conclusion that this was not yet the time to host them. But early in 2022, your Board will be revisiting many of these same questions, and assessing how our situation might have changed by then. So both your new and remaining Board members will appreciate your prayer support as we continue to rely on the Spirit's guidance for our Emmaus Community!

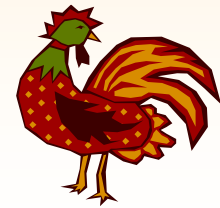
