From time to time, we experience things that warm our hearts and give us encouragement. This happened to me during the Chrysalis closing this past Sept. 7th. During the closing, Brian talked about how we all need to be aware of the Spirit moving around us and how the Spirit may be leading others to act and speak on His behalf. My thoughts went back to the Priesthood of All Believers talk. I think it is important to remember that this talk is not The Priesthood of All Clergy or Priesthood of All Adults. The Body of Christ also talks about how we all have a purpose that is unique to each one of us. Sometimes we may get caught up in what we have to say or what we can do for expanding His kingdom. I watched as parents watched for their sons and daughters and made their way to join them. To me, it was an awesome sight to see these families joined together to receive the body and the blood of Jesus Christ...what a witness to the world that we live in!

I am looking forward now to the upcoming Emmaus walks to see what God is going to do in the lives of the pilgrims and also to see how they will be the reflection of Christ as they greet us at the closings.

The phrase repeated at the end of each Chrysalis talk, "Fly with Christ." I think holds strong meaning for each of us. We all need to "Fly with Christ" in our lives each day as we fulfill the calling that God has given us.
