## **A Note from the Community Lay Director...**

Finally, it is starting to feel like fall and with fall come the Men's and Women's Walks! Over the past couple of weeks, several people told me they had concerns there would not be a Men's Walk with such low numbers early on. And your board gets very concerned – we do not want to have to retire a Walk. It is during these times our faith is so important. We know God will prevail, but our humanness causes us to worry; God speaks to us in His word why worry is not trusting in Him to fulfill His purpose.

Worry is essentially a control issue. It's trying to control the uncontrollable. We can't control how many sponsors are in conversations with potential Pilgrims. So, we worry about Sponsorship and send out emails encouraging everyone to make those final efforts to get Pilgrims signed up. We can't control people's schedules, so we worry about work schedules, special event schedules, etc. We can't control the future, so we worry about the future. But worry never solves anything! It's stewing without doing.

In his Sermon on the Mount, Jesus gives reasons why we don't need to worry. Matthew 6:30 says, *"If God cares so wonderfully for flowers that are here today and gone tomorrow, won't he more surely care for you, O men of little faith?"* (TLB). If you trust in God, you don't need to worry. Why? Because he has promised to take care of all your needs: *"God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus"* (Philippians 4:19 NIV).

So, the bottom line is this – God took care of our needs and both Walks are a Go! Team training is completed, and both teams are ready to make this a memorable experience for the Pilgrims who attend these Walks. Now let's support these Walks with our participation at Send-off, Candlelight and Closing. Don't worry – be faithful and trust in the Lord!

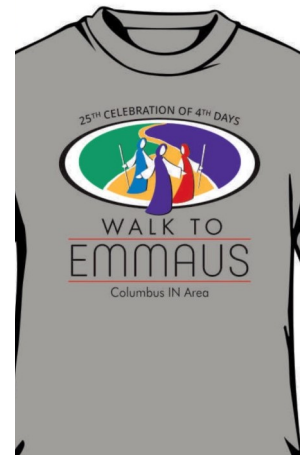

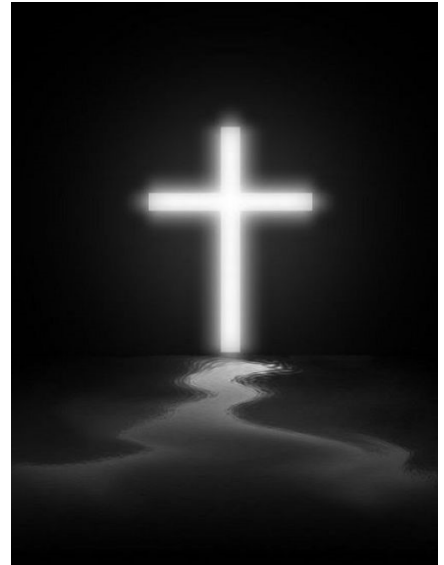
