A Note from Our Community Spiritual Director...

Are we ready to support the Fall Walks? While our Teams are serving the pilgrims, we can be serving those pilgrims & teams through our prayer support!

Some of us will be offered the opportunity to pray during the Talks in the Prayer Chapel at camp. Many more of us will choose to select a half-hour period of time to pray wherever we are at that time. Either way, that can seem to be a long time to be in prayer! So how can we use that prayer time well?

First, go to the website & get the list of both pilgrims and team members. With about 90 persons to pray for, we'll only have about 20 seconds to pray for each one during our half-hour!

If we choose to focus only on the pilgrims in our prayers, then we might have a whole minute to devote to each! But in that short period of time, we might pray for each pilgrim's:

- Spiritual growth that weekend
- Bonding with the other members of their table
- Families as they are away
- Sponsors that are supporting them
- Positive impact on their homes when they return
- Positive impact on their workplaces when they return
- Positive impact on their home churches when they return
- Decisions on how they might impact their communities and the world.



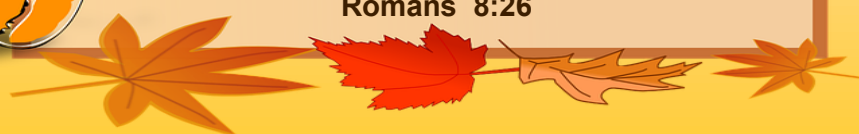
I hope these suggestions will help us in using that half-hour of prayer most effectively. What a blessing we can be as we spend that precious time before the throne of grace!
