In July the community received a very generous gift from Linda Bryer's estate. \$200 of that gift has been sent to the International Walk to Emmaus Headquarters for the support of a new developing community.

Chrysalis Flights 21 and 22 are taking place this Labor Day weekend, September 2-4. Check the website for the scheduled activities. Please keep these young people and the team in your prayers.

Please review the revised community bylaws on the web site. Be ready to vote on their approval at the September Gathering.

Don't forget the last two walks of the year! Men's Walk 61 is October 19-22 with Arnie Elmerick as the Lay Director and Ken Tingley as the Spiritual Director. Women's Walk 62 follows on October 26-29 with Anita Beeker as the Lay Director and Sam Davenport as the Spiritual Director. There is still room for more pilgrims! We need at least 20 pilgrims on each walk for the walks to continue twice a year. A full walk has 36 pilgrims and that's our prayerful goal for each walk. Currently, we have 7 men's and 28 women's applications submitted. Confirmation letters will be sent to the Pilgrims and their sponsors on September 14.

Nominations are being sought for the board of director's class of 2007-2009 for both the Emmaus and Chrysalis communities. The election will be held at the November Gathering.

Why do bylaws exist, and why would anyone be interested in reading them? Most individuals have absolutely no interest in reading them. They lack humor, mystery, romance, violence, excitement, photos, illustrations and actually any kind of stimulating value. In fact one could call bylaws just plain boring. If one were to read the bylaws for enjoyment, that individual would probably fall asleep very quickly. If a good night's sleep is needed, perhaps reading them at bedtime might be helpful. They are not meant to be entertaining, though. Many individuals who should read them do not. Very few members of our community read them unless there is an absolute need to do so which is appropriate.

Then why are bylaws so important? Their significance to our Community cannot be overstated. They are the backbone and structure by which our community functions and the rules that govern the internal affairs of the community.

The Bylaws were last revised in February of 2002. The board that did that revision did a fantastic job the bylaws were informative, accurate and appropriate for our community in 2002. Since then there have been changes in the jobs of the board because of the web site that began in late 2004. There have been a few other minor changes in the way we do business. The current board has completed working on revisions to the bylaws to replace the 2002 Bylaws. There are no drastic changes in the structure or content.
