### Letter to the Community:

#### The Statement and the Possibility of a Life Changing Response

At our last Gathering we had a small technical problem that prevented us from singing as much as we generally do. We had no words. Yes Gents, even the ladies had no words. A very temporary situation I assure you.

But as our God is always apt to do, He gave us a new assignment, which may well have been His agenda from the start. This question came to us: On your Walk or Flight when your lay director said to you, "Christ is counting on you" and you were instructed to respond, "And I am counting on Christ", what did you think and feel as you responded? This question has haunted me all week.

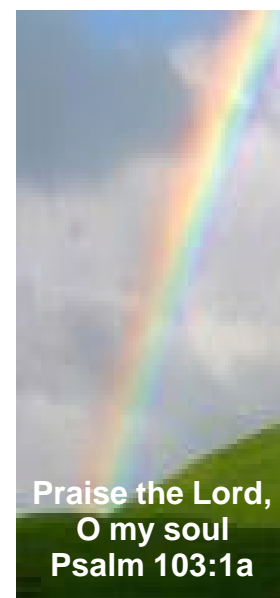
Three brave, faith walkers gave us their answers, one from a Flight two from Walks. It is a courageous thing to put your feelings into words and express them aloud at a meeting even if it is a church related meeting. Others may have responded, but I moved on to the next thing. I wish I had spent more time on that one item. What is **your** answer? Take all the time you need, but please, think about and formulate an answer to this question.

I know when first asked about something, my first answer may not be my final answer. But after spending 72 hours in the lap of God, I suspect, many times our first answer is our best and final answer.

I have been on both sides of the question. Aside from Dying Moments, the Commissioning is the highest point of the Walk for me. As a lay director, I had the privilege of looking down into the eyes of washed clean, hopeful and empowered women that had seen Jesus. I got to lean into their faces and ask them to make a response that would resound in the very halls of Heaven. I wonder if Jesus, on hearing our responses, says to the Father, "These are the ones I have brought to you, just listen to these hearts".

Although the response is prescribed, I have never heard anyone say the words flippantly.

The knowledge that precedes the response is too convicting to allow a glib answer. "Christ is counting on you", is not something that we can dismiss. If we are to be worthy of such an honor, we will definitely need help. Therefore "We are counting on Christ". What was your unspoken response to the throne room of God?

I did not answer the question last Friday night. But I have an answer, a final answer. At the moment of responding to the statement, I knew I would never walk alone. I would always be well accompanied in life, in death, or whatever came my way. I was, on that very day, five days away from my sixth chemo-therapy treatment. My hair was barely there, my shirt hung empty and I had never been so beautiful in all my life.
